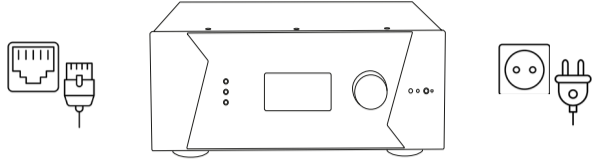

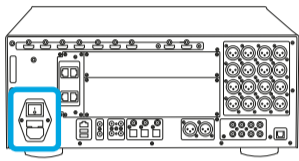
1 Connect your device

1. Connect your AC cable to a grounded outlet and your RJ45 LAN cable to your local router.

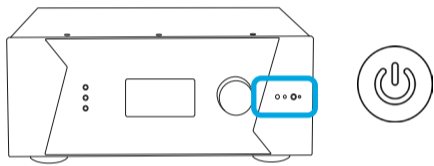


2. Connect your inputs and outputs to the processor.

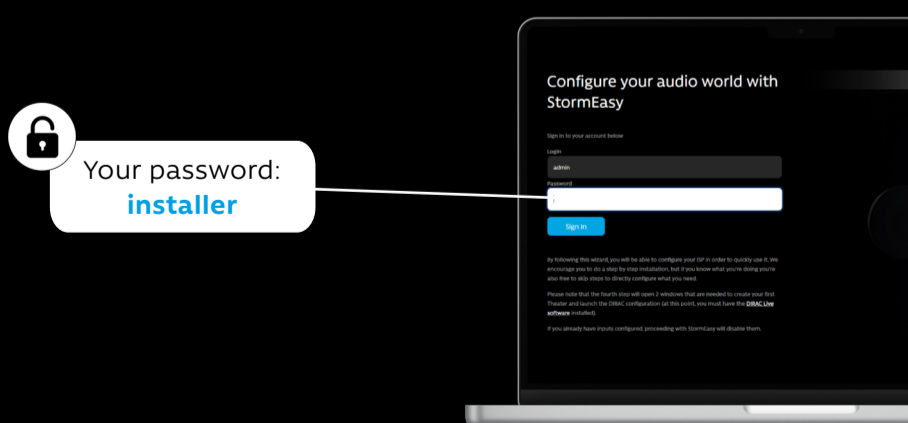

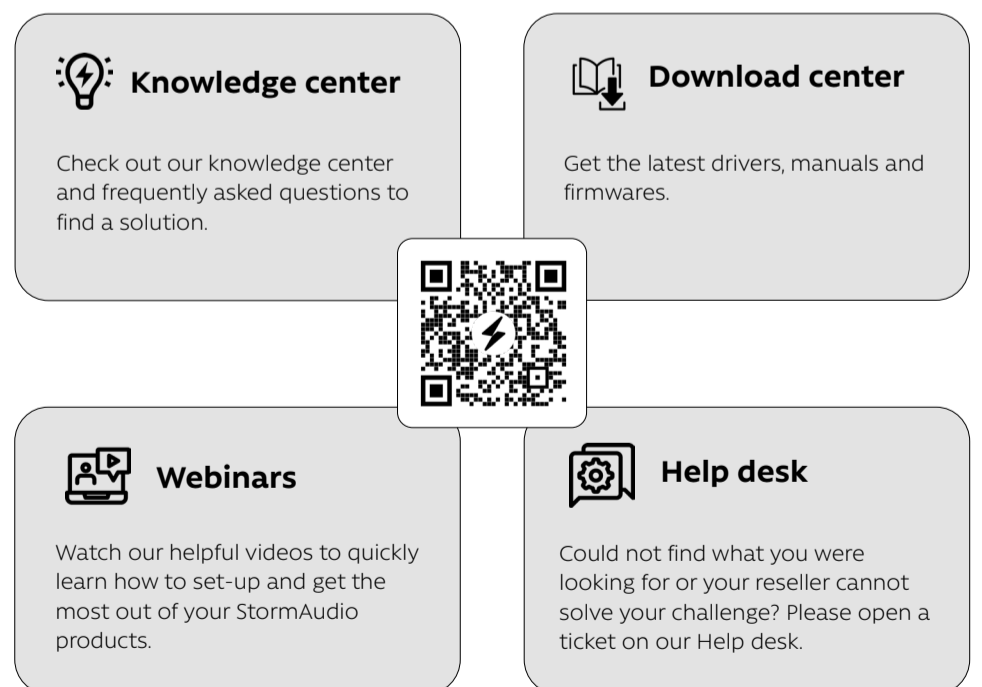
